Subject: Seven Eleven at Arlington's Williamsburg Shopping Center Renovates

Arlington, Virginia November 6, 2019 – Seven Eleven has renovated its store in Arlington's Williamsburg Shopping Center. Seven Eleven store number 35372 is located mid-way between Bishop O'Connell and Yorktown High Schools. This store, originally a Highs Dairy Store, opened at this center in the mid 1950s.

What started out as an icehouse in Dallas, Texas, back in 1927 has grown and evolved into the world's largest operator, franchisor, and licensor of convenience stores. In 1946, its owners change their store names from Tote'm Stores to 7-Eleven. Founded by Joe C. Thompson Jr., Seven-Eleven operates, franchises, and licenses approximately 7,600 stores in the U.S. and Canada. Of the more than 6,500 stores the company operates and franchises in the United States, more than 4,900 are franchised. Outside of the U.S. and Canada, there are over 68,000 7-Eleven and other convenience stores in Hong Kong, Japan, Taiwan, Thailand, South Korea, China, Malaysia, Mexico, Singapore, Australia, Philippines, Indonesia, Vietnam, Norway, Sweden, Turkey, and Denmark.

Seven Eleven is conveniently located near the East Falls Church Metro station in the Williamsburg Shopping Center (at the intersection of Sycamore and Williamsburg Blvd) in Arlington.
